The Word Became Flesh

- J 1:1 **In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.**
 In the beginning was the WHAT? ▶ Word
 and the Word was with WHOM? ▶ God
 and the Word was WHO? ▶ God
- J 1:2 **He was in the beginning with God.**
 He was in the WHAT with God? ▶ beginning
- J 1:3 **All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.**
 WHAT were made through him? ▶ All things
 and without him was not WHAT made that was made? ▶ any thing
- J 1:4 **In him was life, and the life was the light of men.**
 In him was WHAT? ▶ life
 and the life was the WHAT? ▶ light of men
- J 1:5 **The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.**
 The light shines in the WHAT? ▶ darkness
 and the darkness has not DONE WHAT? ▶ overcome it
- J 1:6 **There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.**
 There was a WHAT sent from God? ▶ man
 whose name was WHAT? ▶ John
- J 1:7 **He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him.**
 He came as a WHAT? ▶ witness
 to DO WHAT about the light? ▶ bear witness
 that all might DO WHAT through him? ▶ believe
- J 1:8 **He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.**
 He was not the WHAT? ▶ light
 but came to DO WHAT about the light? ▶ bear witness
- J 1:9 **The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.**
 The true light, which gives light to WHOM? ▶ everyone
 was coming into WHAT? ▶ the world
- J 1:10 **He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.**
 He was in the world, and the world was WHAT? ▶ made through him
 yet the world did not DO WHAT? ▶ know him

J 1:11	He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him.	
	He came to his own, and his own WHAT?	▶ people
	his own people did not DO WHAT?	▶ receive him
J 1:12	But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,	
	But to all who did receive him, who believed in WHAT?	▶ his name
	he gave the right to become WHAT?	▶ children of God
J 1:13	who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.	
	who were born, not of WHAT? (3)	▶ blood ▶ the will of the flesh ▶ the will of man
	but of WHOM?	▶ God
● J 1:14	And the Word became flesh and <u>dwelt</u> among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.	
	And the Word became WHAT?	▶ flesh
	and DID WHAT?	▶ dwelt among us
	and we have seen his WHAT?	▶ glory
	glory as of the only WHAT?	▶ Son
	the only Son from WHOM?	▶ the Father
	full of WHAT? (2)	▶ grace ▶ truth
J 1:15	(John bore witness about him, and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.'")	
	John bore witness about him, and DID WHAT?	▶ cried out
	"This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes WHEN?	▶ after me
	ranks WHERE?	▶ before me
	because he was WHEN?	▶ before me
J 1:16	For from his <u>fullness</u> we have all received, grace <u>upon</u> grace.	
	For from his fullness we have all received, WHAT?	▶ grace upon grace
J 1:17	For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.	
	For the law was given through WHOM?	▶ Moses
	WHAT came through Jesus Christ? (2)	▶ grace ▶ truth
J 1:18	No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.	
	No one has ever seen WHO?	▶ God
	the only God, who is at the WHAT?	▶ Father's side
	he has DONE WHAT?	▶ made him known
<i>The Testimony of John the Baptist</i>		
J 1:19	And this is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent priests and <u>Levites</u> from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?"	
	And this is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent WHAT? (2)	▶ priests ▶ Levites
	from WHERE to ask him?	▶ Jerusalem
	to ask him, WHAT?	▶ "Who are you?"
J 1:20	He confessed, and did not <u>deny</u>, but confessed, "I am not the Christ."	
	He confessed, and did not DO WHAT?	▶ deny
	but confessed, "I am not WHO?	▶ the Christ

J 1:21	And they asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" He said, "I am not." "Are you the Prophet?" And he answered, "No."	
	And they asked him, "What then? Are you WHO?	▶ Elijah
	He said, WHAT?	▶ "I am not."
	"Are you the WHAT?	▶ Prophet
	And he answered, WHAT?	▶ "No."
J 1:22	So they said to him, "Who are you? We need to give an answer to those who sent us. What do you say about yourself?"	
	So they said to him, "Who are you? We need to give WHAT to those who sent us?	▶ an answer
	What do you say about WHO?	▶ yourself
J 1:23	He said, "I am the voice of one crying out in the wilderness, 'Make <u>straight</u> the way of the Lord,' as the prophet Isaiah said."	
	He said, "I am the voice of one DOING WHAT?	▶ crying out
	crying out in the WHAT?	▶ wilderness
	'Make straight the WHAT?	▶ way of the Lord
	as the prophet WHO said?	▶ Isaiah
J 1:24	(Now they had been sent from the Pharisees.)	
	Now they had been sent from WHOM?	▶ the Pharisees
J 1:25	They asked him, "Then why are you baptizing, if you are neither the Christ, nor Elijah, nor the Prophet?"	
	They asked him, "Then why are you DOING WHAT?	▶ baptizing
	if you are neither WHO? (3)	▶ the Christ ▶ Elijah ▶ the Prophet
J 1:26	John answered them, "I baptize with water, but among you stands one you do not know,	
	John answered them, "I baptize with WHAT?	▶ water
	but among you stands WHO?	▶ one you do not know
J 1:27	even he who comes after me, the <u>strap</u> of whose <u>sandal</u> I am not <u>worthy</u> to <u>untie</u>."	
	even he who comes after me, the WHAT of whose sandal?	▶ strap
	I am not worthy to WHAT?	▶ untie
J 1:28	These things took place in Bethany across the Jordan, where John was baptizing.	
	These things took place in WHAT PLACE?	▶ Bethany
	across the WHAT?	▶ Jordan
	where John was DOING WHAT?	▶ baptizing
	<i>Behold, the Lamb of God</i>	
● J 1:29	The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"	
	The next day he saw Jesus DOING WHAT?	▶ coming toward him
	and said, "Behold, WHO?	▶ the Lamb of God
	who takes away the WHAT?	▶ sin of the world
J 1:30	This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks before me, because he was before me.'	
	This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who DOES WHAT?	▶ ranks before me
	because he was WHEN?	▶ before me

J 1:31	I myself did not know him, but for this purpose I came baptizing with water, that he might be revealed to Israel."
	I myself did not DO WHAT? ▶ know him
	but for this purpose I came DOING WHAT? ▶ baptizing with water
	that he might be WHAT? ▶ revealed to Israel
J 1:32	And John bore witness: "I saw the Spirit descend from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him.
	And John bore witness: "I saw WHO descend? ▶ the Spirit
	descend from WHERE? ▶ heaven
	like a WHAT? ▶ dove
	and it DID WHAT on him? ▶ remained
J 1:33	I myself did not know him, but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.'
	I myself did not know him, but he who sent me to DO WHAT? ▶ baptize with water
	said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit DO WHAT? (2) ▶ descend
	▶ remain
	this is he who DOES WHAT? ▶ baptizes
	this is he who baptizes with WHO? ▶ the Holy Spirit
● J 1:34	And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God."
	And I have seen and have DONE WHAT? ▶ borne witness
	that this is WHO? ▶ the Son of God
<i>Jesus Calls the First Disciples</i>	
J 1:35	The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples,
	The next day again John was standing with WHOM? ▶ two of his disciples
J 1:36	and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!"
	and he looked at Jesus as he DID WHAT? ▶ walked by
	and said, "Behold, WHO? ▶ the Lamb of God
J 1:37	The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus.
	The two disciples heard him say this, and they DID WHAT? ▶ followed Jesus
J 1:38	Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, "What are you seeking?" And they said to him, "Rabbi" (which means Teacher), "where are you staying?"
	Jesus turned and saw them DOING WHAT? ▶ following
	and said to them, "What are you WHAT? ▶ seeking
	And they said to him, "WHAT"? ▶ Rabbi
	"Rabbi" (which means WHAT? ▶ Teacher
	"where are you WHAT? ▶ staying
J 1:39	He said to them, "Come and you will see." So they came and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day, for it was about the tenth hour.
	He said to them, "Come and you will DO WHAT? ▶ see
	So they came and saw where he was DOING WHAT? ▶ staying
	and they stayed with him WHEN? ▶ that day
	for it was about the WHAT? ▶ tenth hour
J 1:40	One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.
	One of the two who heard John DO WHAT? ▶ speak
	and followed Jesus was WHO? ▶ Andrew
	Andrew, WHOSE brother? ▶ Simon Peter's
